Put your recyclables in your cart that is dark green with a red lid. Put at the curb with the handles facing the house 3ft from the trash container or any other objects.

Some additional recyclable items you may not have sorted before:

- Newspapers
- Newspaper Inserts
- Magazines
- Phone Books
- Catalogs
- Old Training Manuals
- Junk Mail
- Envelopes
- File Folders
- Not Very Good Paper Back Books
- Office & School Papers (all colors)
- Fax Sheets
- PET #1 • soft drinks bottles, water bottles, salad dressing bottles, peanut butter & jelly jars
- HDPE#2 • juice bottles, water bottles, shampoo bottles, laundry detergent bottles
- Corrugated Cardboard
Please flatten, bundle & cut to 3'x3'x1' (Please place next to the recycle cart)
- Box Board (cereal, cake, cracker, tissue & shoe boxes)
- Brown Paper Bags
- Aluminum Cans
- Tin & Steel Cans
- Glass Jars and Bottles
three colors only (brown, green, clear)
- Plastic Milk Jugs
- Plastic Bottles with Necks

Most common contaminants

Please avoid placing the following containers in the recycling.

- Pizza Boxes with food residue
- Oil Containers with residue

How to Prepare

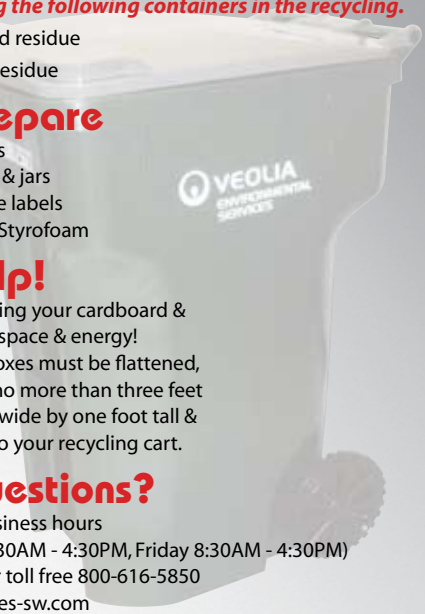
- Remove caps & lids
- Rinse cans, bottles & jars
- No need to remove labels
- No Plastic Bags or Styrofoam

Please Help!

- Remember, flattening your cardboard & paperboard saves space & energy!
- Extra cardboard boxes must be flattened, tied into bundles no more than three feet long by three feet wide by one foot tall & then placed next to your recycling cart.
