City of St. Charles Collection Guidelines



Proper Container Placement

Set out trash and recycling carts prior to 6:00 a.m. on your scheduled collection day. Be sure to have at least three feet of clearance on all sides. Please put your recycling in your container labeled recycling – no sorting needed.



Curbside Garbage Collection

THE FOLLOWING CAN GO OUT WITH YOUR REGULAR WEEKLY GARBAGE:

- Vacuum cleaners
- Hoses
- Ironing board/iron
- Egg cartons
- Hardcover books
- Broken toys
- Styrofoam
- Caps and lids
- Small appliances (*toasters, mixers, blenders*)
- Plastic cutlery
- Empty aerosol paint cans
- Clothing (*or donate*)
- Ceramics and dishes
- Disposable diapers
- Preformed plastic packaging
- Empty prescription bottles
- Motor oil and anti-freeze containers
- Ribbons or foil wrapping paper
- Broken glass, mirrors and window glass
- Pizza boxes/take-out containers/dirty or soiled paper and food soiled boxes
- Latex paint cans (*containing hardened or solidified paint; leave tops off*)
- Pet waste and litter (*double bagged and tied shut*)



Curbside Recycling Collection

THE FOLLOWING CAN GO OUT WITH YOUR REGULAR BI-WEEKLY RECYCLING:

- Newspapers
- Newspaper inserts
- Brown Paper Bags
- Corrugated Cardboard (*flattened*)
- Magazines
- Catalogs
- Box Board (*cereal, cake, cracker, tissue and shoe boxes*)
- Phone Books
- Aluminum, Tin & Steel cans
- Junk mail
- Envelopes
- Fax Sheets
- Plastic cups
- Frozen food boxes
- Office & School papers (*all colors*)
- File Folders
- Glass Jars & Bottles (*three colors only – brown, green, clear*)
- Shampoo, conditioner bottles
- Yogurt, dairy & margarine tubs
- Milk, juice, soup and ice cream cartons
- All Food & Beverage plastics (*labeled #1 - #7*)
- **Empty and rinse containers – lids and caps go in the garbage**

UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS:

- **Plastics without a recycle symbol or above #7 grade**
- **Oil containers with residue**
- **Pizza boxes with food residue**



Household Hazardous Waste

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE WILL NOT BE COLLECTED CURBSIDE AND CAN BE DROPPED OFF AT THE FOLLOWING LOCATIONS:

- Household Hazardous Waste Facility: 225 West 2nd Street, Winona (507) 457-6405
- Olmsted County Recycling Center Plus: 305 Silver Creek Rd NE, Rochester (507) 328-7070

Items include: paint, stain/varnish, cleaners, gasoline, fuels, solvents, antifreeze, motor oil/filters, aerosol cans, pesticides, fluorescent bulbs, rechargeable batteries, propane cylinders, residential sharps, acids/bases, button batteries (hearing aid, watches & other electronics), rechargeable batteries. **No auto batteries, ammunition, TV's or electronics!**



How to Prepare

- Lids left on bottles and cans can be recycled
- Rinse cans, bottles and jars
- No need to remove labels
- No Styrofoam
- Flatten your cardboard and paperboard to save space and energy.



Medications

Old or unused medications may be dropped off at the St. Charles Police Department located at 830 Whitewater Ave. Make sure all labels are blackened out and bottles put into a bag. Please ring the doorbell beside the Police Department door for service.
