1. ESTABLISH QUORUM/CALL TO ORDER

Quorum was present with Mayor Schaber calling the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

- **4. St. Charles Ambulance.** The council discussed reclaiming the St. Charles license for the ambulance service, funding, and the possibility of forming a Joint Powers Agreement (JPA). The council directed Administrator Langholz to finalize the contracts and work with crew members to develop a steering committee to pursue reclaiming ownership of the license.
- **5. South Fork Fifth Addition (SFFA).** Mr. Langholz stated that the SFFA would be postponed till fall of 2022. He continues to work with the developer to develop a sketch plan for the entire subdivision.
- **6. Compensation Study.** Mr. Langholz stated that there a several positions that the council may want to address during the 2024 and 2025 budgets for adjustment. He continues to work through the compensation study to provide them with accurate information.
- **7. Sergeant Jones Step & Wage Recalculation.** The council discussed an oversight that occurred regarding compensation when promoting Officer Brady Jones to the Sergeant position.
- **8. Part-time Police Officers.** The council discussed the possibility of adding additional part-time police officers to cover vacation, sick, comp, or unpaid leave situations within the department. Mr. Langholz was directed to meet with Chief Pelaez, Sergeant Jones, and other officers to discuss the possibility and develop a plan.
- **9. Public Works Director Position.** Mr. Langholz requested input from the council regarding filling the Public Works Director position upon Mr. Karger's retirement. The council is considering promoting Scott Bunke to the position, as he has been working as the interim when Mr. Karger has been absent. The council directed Mr. Langholz to speak with the city attorney to ensure the legality of this process, or whether there needs to be an internal or external posting for the position.
- **10. Street Vacation.** Mr. Langholz reviewed the stipulations associated with vacating a street with the council. The council discussed access to the parcels west of the proposed vacation.

11. Laserfiche. Administrator Langholz explained that Laserfiche is a software that he would like to use for record management. The software would allow the reduction and permanent safekeeping of records that are required to be maintained by the city. He has directed staff to generate an RFP that will be sent to vendors for costs associated with its implementation and upkeep.

- -Attached you will find additional reports that I will attempt to include each month for you. The yearly incident report and calls by shift should already be familiar to you. SC Ambulance responded to 27 incidents in March. 10 additional incidents were handled by other agencies (9 Lewiston, 1 Altura). I'm also including a monthly incident detail report so you can see where that information is pulled from. New reports include a copy of the March on-call schedule which details how we provided coverage along with a report that shows individual call hours for each member. 31 days x 24 hours of coverage= 744 hours needed. Keep in mind that 2 people are required to cover the schedule. With the help of Lewiston staff we covered the truck 653.5 of 744 hours (88%). If no staff available the truck then came out of Lewiston (90.5 hours) during the month (12%). If we would not have used Lewiston staff to assist, then only 536.5 hours of the 744 required (72%) would there have been a SC truck staffed.
- -I've attached a current roster of the members assigned to just the St. Charles station. This roster is current as of 4/1/23.
- -Renee Hewitt resigned from the Ambulance Service effective 3/31/23. We thank Renee for 20 years of service in EMS and all that she has done for the St. Charles community and surrounding area!
- -Training was conducted on 03/08/23 and provided by SE EMS. Members trained on Adult Cardiac Arrest Management. A staff meeting was held prior to the training and our Medical Director Dr. Dennis Laudon was present virtually. We recently celebrated "National Doctor's Day" and we can't thank Dr. Laudon enough for all of the work he does to provide Medical Direction to both St. Charles & Lewiston Ambulance as well as the SE Regional Program!
- -Members were informed back in February that they will be required to take 36 hours of call time per month effective 4/1/23. This falls under the standard that members in Lewiston are held to.
- -Administrator Langholz has reached out to the members of SC Ambulance and has been conducting individual meetings with the crew. He is planning to attend our staff meeting on 4/12 and speak with the group.
- -Crew is nearing completion of a recruitment packet that will roll out the end of April/beginning of May. Our goal is to recruit new volunteers over the next few months with a class to be held in St. Charles in September of 2023.
- -Part-Time EMT positions were posted the end of March as we are searching for 2 individuals to hire. Their primary responsibilities would be to provide coverage at the St. Charles station. First review of applicants will be on 4/7.


April 11, 2023 Council Report


